# OLD PUBLIC HALL OF HAKODATE WARD

### Overview of the Hall

Old public Hall of Hakodate Ward is one of the most iconic Western-style building in the city of Hakodate at the top of Motoi-zaka slope. In 1974, the national government designated it as an Important Cultural Property. After two-time large-scale repair constructions, the Hall, with two-tone facade of bluish-gray and yellow and its elegant interior, revived in the image of Meiji era.

## History of the Hall

- 1907 Aug. A town assembly hall was burned down in a big fire.
- Sep. A conference was initiated to discuss construction of a new assembly hall.
- 1908 Dec. The Industrialist and statesman, Souma Teppei donated 50,000yen.
- 1909 Feb. Engineer Konishi Asajiro conducted architectural surveys in each place. May Construction of the Hall started.

Oct. Ridgepole-raising ceremony. Takeuchi, the head of a ward, went on a inspection tour in Tokyo to search furniture.

1910 Sep. Opening ceremony.


- 1911 Aug. The Crown Prince visited the hall. (the person who became Emperor Taisho later.)
- 1922 Jul. The Prince Regent visited the hall. (the person who became Emperor Showa later.)

Aug. Municipalization of Hakodate was celebrated.

- 1927 May The Novelists Akutagawa Ryunosuke and Satomi Ton gave a lecture to an audience of a thousand people.
- 1945 Nov. The Hall was used as Hakodate district army headquarters.
- 1946 Jan. The Hall was used as Yunokawa National Hospital and Hakodate National Hospital.
- 1951 Mar. The Hall was used as the local Marine Accidents Tribunal.
- 1957 Oct. The Hall was reopened as a Public Hall.
- 1971 Mar. The Hall was designated as a Tangible Cultural Property of Hokkaido.
- 1974 May The Hall was designated as an Important Cultural Property of Japan.
- 1980 Oct. The preservation repair of the Hall began.
- Dec. Annex building was designated as an Important Cultural Property of Japan.
- 1982 Nov. The preservation repair of the Hall was completed (The hall was restored
  - in the same condition as at the time of 1911.)
- 1983 Apr. The Hall was open to the public.
- 1989 Oct. The Emperor and Empress of Japan visited the Hall.
- 2018 Oct. The preservation repair of the Hall including earthquake resistance construction began.
- 2021 Mar. The preservation repair of the Hall was completed.

Apr. The Hall was reopened to the public.

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
